Called to Holiness and Mission

Bishop Martino has asked us to be part of the current cycle of parish planning related to the **Called to Holiness and Mission**. His expectation is that each parish will find neighboring parishes with whom to plan in or to:

1. Share more resources with each other and with Parishes in need.
2. Avoid unneeded duplication of services.
3. Fill in the gaps where services and ministry have not been available. We hope to work with the parish of St. Jude’s in Mountain Top.

The following people are on the CORE committee to do parish planning as part of the **Called to Holiness and Mission**. Father Mark Honhart, Chair Marc Mickowski, Sue Miller, Molly Mendofik and Elaine Stevens. The CORE Committee attended a training session to become acquainted with the materials we will be using to assess our parish ministries.

The CORE team will be overseeing the evaluation of parish ministries based on the Criteria for planning. The Criteria are divided into five categories: Eucharist; Prayer and Communion; Evangelization and Formation; Vocation; Stewardship and Justice; and Stewardship and Administration.
