ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME **JUNE 15, 2008**

“At the sight of the crowds, Jesus’ heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. Then He said to the disciples, the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for His harvest ... Then He summoned His twelve apostles.”

I wonder what Jesus would think, say and do, as He looks upon us in the Church today. I am sure He would be pleased with many elements of our faith and dedication, yet also be hurting for our indifference, infidelity and parochialism. His pity is marked by compassion and concern for the well-being of all.

He is calling all to satisfy the needs of His Church. He needs priests to celebrate the Sacraments. As you read this pray that others will follow His call. Encourage a person you feel has a religious vocation to be a priest, religious or deacon. Support the many lay ministries in your parish. Catechists, liturgical ministers, home visitors make the message of Christ touch others. Your faith was sown by someone else, maybe you are the choice Christ has made to be a laborer for His harvest, someone waiting to know Christ's love. Cardinal Newman in his eloquent prayer says that God has entrusted to me a ministry, which if I fail to do it, it will always remain undone. The gospel mandate today is to ask the master to send, and for me to do my part. He did not just “call” the apostles, He “summoned” them. I wonder if the message is more urgent today than when Jesus looked upon the crowd in the Gospel.
