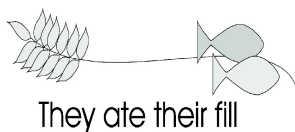

EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

AUGUST 3, 2008

"What will separate us from the love of Christ?" ...
"Come to me heedfully, listen, that you may have life. I will renew with you my everlasting covenant, the benefits assured to David" ... "His heart was moved with pity for them ... There is no need for them to go away; give them food yourselves."

All three readings provide a line or two for the reflection today. As I answer the opening question, I know it is only sin, or being unfaithful to grace that can cause a breach with the Lord. For this reason I try to listen more carefully to what God says to me in the scripture today. I am the hungry, thirsty, poor person and He alone can and wishes to satisfy me.

The multitude in the desert were provided for all their needs. There was no need for them to go away, the resources were at hand. The same is true as we look around us today. We might think we will run short or have to sacrifice something of ourselves. Why not? The miracle of Jesus was astounding. How it was accomplished is beyond our grasp.

What isn't beyond me is the motive of Jesus then and now. His heart was moved with pity. In our parish, in our local community, in our world, others are looking for the hand of Jesus to touch them. Our response to the marginalized or excluded, will allow the face of Christ to be seen. Those to whom we respond are the face of Christ for us today.

St. Vincent de Paul reminds us that it is not the bread which we give that is important, but the love, care or "pity of Christ" that is revealed. Remember not the miracle but the motive.

Lifeline - The Church....is called to proclaim the gift of life, to serve life, and to promote a culture of life, ...The proclamation of life, life in abundance must be the heart of the new evangelization. For true life—our salvation—can only be found in the reconciliation, freedom and love which are God's gracious gifts.
